This position will operate with a significant amount of independence and will enable an entrepreneurial and business-minded individual the opportunity to significantly enhance the Lander experience for students, faculty, and staff through a variety of different areas of influence. Serving as part of a dynamic team under the VPFA will ensure that the units for which they provide leadership are moving Lander forward on all of its important strategic initiatives, operating with honesty, openness, courtesy, and respect.

Duties and Responsibilities:

The AVP will provide leadership to unit heads responsible for these areas, manage the budgets within these areas, and work in support of the mission and goals of the Finance and Administration division. The Facilities division comprises roughly 75 staff spread across an array of departments. The AVP will lead and grow this staff in accordance with the University mission and in service to Lander's students and the campus community. This individual will be responsible for:

- Chairing the Space Utilization Committee and building the Project Request process.
- Managing personnel, including writing position descriptions, EPMS performance/evaluation, training, counseling and promotion.
- Leading the Lander University Physical Plant, which includes roughly 65 staff members in a wide variety of roles supporting building maintenance, grounds maintenance, custodial, central receiving, motor pool/short-term vehicle leasing, and the University Lockshop.
- Overseeing the Lander University Transportation Department, which operates the Lander Line and the Bearcat Shuttle, running routes connecting the local community to Greenwood and other nearby areas.
- Leading the Lander University Special Events staff, which works closely with the facilities team to plan and manage the many special uses for the Lander campus.
- Overseeing the Lander University Equestrian Center, the first university-based equestrian facility in South Carolina to offer academic, therapeutic, and sporting opportunities for students and community members. The complex consists of 37 beautiful acres featuring 26 stalls, a 300' x 150' covered arena, a 190' x 140' outdoor arena, and 19 different pastures.
- Managing the Work Order System.
- Creating status reports on operational and capital projects.
- Campus-wide energy management and reporting. Helping to prioritize energy efficiency measures to lower the campus carbon footprint while saving on utility costs.
- Leading the process of consolidating Scheduling, Fleet Management, and Space Utilization.
- Announcing to campus through mass communication about facilities activities, weather preparation, etc., as needed.
- Supporting the Campus Emergency Response Plan and Facilities Master Planning, in collaboration with the VPFA.

Richard E. Cosentino, Ph.D., began his tenure as Lander University's 12th president on July 1, 2015. He has over 30 years of experience in higher education as a senior administrative and financial executive and a background in fundraising, enrollment management, and governmental relations.

Dr. Cosentino came to Lander from the University of North Carolina at Pembroke (UNC-P), where he was the Vice Chancellor for Finance & Administration. He was responsible for strategic management and leadership in over a dozen areas, including budget and financial planning, information technology, human resources, risk management, procurement, and facilities management. A native of Baltimore, MD, Dr. Cosentino has a Bachelor of Science in business administration with a major in finance and a Master of Business Administration with a major in strategic financial planning from the University of Baltimore in Maryland. He earned a Ph.D. in engineering from The George Washington University (GWU) in Washington, D.C.

Prior to UNC-P, Dr. Cosentino was an Assistant and Associate Vice President for Finance and Administration at GWU and Vice Dean for Finance and Administrative Affairs in the University's School of Engineering and Applied Science. He also worked as a Senior Budget Manager at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine and as a Senior Administrator and Director of Budget and Finance at the University of Maryland School of Medicine. He has presented at national conferences, addressing contemporary issues affecting higher education. His particular interest is the fielding of complex enterprise class systems in higher education environments.
